



CPRA Contracted Services

Project Construction Services — Title 38, Public Bid Law

- Louisiana Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) administers the advertisement/bid process.
- Advertisements are posted on the CPRA website: <http://coastal.la.gov/resources/rfps-rsiqs-contracts/bids/>
- Ads are placed in the Official State Journal (The Advocate) and the Official Journal of the parish where the project is located (3) three times.
- A contractor can request to receive notice of a construction advertisement by emailing their contact information to: cpra.bidding@la.gov

Project Other — Title 39, Public Procurement Code

(maintenance and repair work on existing projects or debris removal type work)

- The Office of State Procurement (OSP) handles the advertisement/bid process for CPRA.
- Advertisements are posted on the Louisiana Office of State Procurement – LaPac Website: <https://wwwcfprd.doa.louisiana.gov/osp/lapac/pubMain.cfm>
- A contractor can be placed on an OSP list to receive notice of an advertisement by registering with Office of State Purchasing: <http://www.doa.la.gov/pages/OSP/purchasing/vendorcenter.aspx>

Engineering, Surveying, and Geotechnical services - Title 39, Public Procurement Code

- Louisiana Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) administers the advertisement/bid process.
- Generally, these services are acquired through a Request for Solicitation of Interest and Qualifications (RSIQ) process, and a Professional Services Contract is awarded to one or more contractors. Task Orders are issued from these contracts for work needed.
- The RSIQ is posted on the CPRA website: <http://coastal.la.gov/resources/rfps-rsiqs-contracts/contracts-and-grants/>
- Ads are placed in the Official State Journal (The Advocate) and The Times-Picayune (3) three times.
- A contractor can request to receive notice of an RSIQ advertisement by emailing their contact information to: CPRAcontracts@la.gov

Environmental Science Consulting and Land Rights Services - Title 39, Public Procurement Code

- Louisiana Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) administers the advertisement/bid process.
- These services are acquired through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process and a Consulting Services Contract is awarded to one or more contractors. Task Orders are issued from these contracts for work needed.
- The RFP is advertised:
