



CPRA to Hold Public Hearing on Revisions to Proposed Rule for Natural Resource Damage Restoration Banking Program

The Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) Board published a Notice of Intent (Notice) to promulgate a Rule to establish a Natural Resource Damage Restoration Banking Program in the January 20, 2017 edition of the *Louisiana Register* (LR 43:128-136). The Notice solicited public comments on the proposed Rule. As a result of its consideration of the written comments received, CPRA proposes to amend §101.B, §107.B, §111.A.5, §115.B.1, §115.B.3.a-d, §115.B.6, §115.C.3, §115.C.5, §117.A.2-10, §117.D, §121.C, §121.D, §123.C, and §127.A.4. The proposed amendments and revisions will be published in the May edition of the Louisiana Register.

In accordance with R.S. 49:968(H)(2), a public hearing on these proposed substantive changes will be held on June 26, 2017, at 1:00 p.m., at CPRA, 150 Terrace Ave., Baton Rouge, LA 70802.
