This addendum shall be considered part of the Plans, Specifications, and Contract Documents (except as noted otherwise) and is issued to change, amplify, or delete from or otherwise explain these documents where provisions of this addendum differ from those of the original documents. This addendum shall have precedence over the original documents and shall govern.

I. Questions

- 1. Question:** The bid says the contractor can keep the weir box and geo tube at his private farm. They do not specifically say if contractor can keep Geo Textile fabric. The question is can contractor keep Geo Textile Fabric?

Answer: The contractor may keep material removed from the island if certification is provided stating the location to which the materials were sent and that the State is no longer responsible for the materials.

- 2. Question:** Anchor tube that will remain on bay side how close does Geo Textile have to be cut? (Some of the Geo Textile is under mud line)

Answer: Geotextile shall be cut at the mudline as close to the anchor tube as possible.
