



## Tangipahoa Parish Coastal Projects

### ENGINEERING AND DESIGN

#### **Manchac Landbridge Shoreline Protection (PO-0183)**

RESTORE MATCHING – Estimated Cost \$3,000,000

This project continues the Shoreline Protection project on the Lake Pontchartrain shoreline southwest of the Tangipahoa River and east of Pass Manchac. This project preserves shoreline integrity and reduces wetland degradation from wave erosion along the shoreline of Lake Pontchartrain, benefitting surrounding shoreline habitat.

### NRDA REC USE PROJECTS

#### **Statewide Artificial Reefs**

NRDA – LDWF – Estimated Cost \$6,000,000

This project enhances eleven multipurpose reef sites across coastal Louisiana.

### 2017 COASTAL MASTER PLAN PROJECTS

#### *Restoration Projects: Year 1-10*

**Manchac Landbridge Shoreline Protection (001.SP.01)** – Shoreline protection through rock breakwaters designed to an elevation of 3.5 feet NAVD88 along approximately 5,500 feet of the west side of Lake Pontchartrain north of Pass Manchac near Stinking Bayou to preserve shoreline integrity and reduce wetland degradation from wave erosion.

\*\*\*Note: Tangipahoa Parish may also receive some benefits from sediment diversion projects in adjacent parishes.
