ADDENDUM I QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

1. Q. Section 1.3 SIQ Submittal and Schedule states “Firms electing to submit a SIQ as a prime contractor cannot be listed as a subcontractor on another firms SIQ. Firms not submitting as prime contractor are allowed to be listed as a subcontractor on as many SIQs as they deem appropriate. **Please note, firms who are prime contractors on existing contracts with CPRA are not prohibited from participating as a subcontractor on this advertisement.**”
 - Is this meant to restrict firms who have an existing contract with CPRA for General Engineering services as a prime contractor from submitting as prime on this contract?
- A. **If a firm holds an existing engineering services IDIQ contract (General, Coastal, or Limited Services), they are not prohibited from submitting as a Prime on any of the advertised RSIQs for engineering services IDIQ contracts; however, it has been the Agency’s practice to not execute multiple engineering services IDIQ contracts with the same firm. In the event a firm holding an existing engineering services IDIQ contract is awarded a new contract under any of the engineering solicitations, the Agency will seek termination of the existing contract prior to executing a new contract.**
2. Q. Should the “Certification Statement” be completed by subcontractors also or just the prime contractor?
- A. **Only primes are required to submit the Certification Statement.**
