



CPRA Extends Public Comment Period for Proposed Rule to Establish Natural Resource Damage Restoration Banking Program

On January 20, 2017, the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority (CPRA) published in the January 2017 Louisiana Register a proposed rule to establish a natural resource damage (NRD) restoration banking program. Pursuant to the corresponding Notice of Intent, CPRA requested public comments be submitted no later than 4:30 p.m. on February 9, 2017.

CPRA hereby extends the public comment period for the NRD restoration banking program to 4:30 p.m. on March 1, 2017. Interested persons commenting should reference the proposed Rule by using the term Natural Resource Damage Restoration Banking.
