#### **Educational Highlights**

- Ambassadors have completed workshops such as
  - GIS and Story Maps Introduction
  - Surveying Aquatic Species using a Seine Net
  - Wetlands Plant Identification

## **Accomplishments**

- Over 32 high school 4-H members have served as wetland ambassadors.
  - At least 2 alumni have continued their wetlands education and leadership into college with plans to pursue a career in a related field.
  - One current ambassador also plans to pursue a career related to wetlands.









### **Accomplishments**

- Since 2019, wetland ambassadors reached over 8,225 people through leading wetlands education activities at 43 outreach events.
  - This program year, ambassadors have reached over 2,000 people through five outreach events so far.
