FY24 Parish Matching Program Introduction

- CPRA's initial effort to replace funding used for Freshwater Reintroduction into Maurepas Swamp last year
- New reimbursement grant matching program with \$7m of surplus and GOMESA funding to match with Parishes on their priority projects
- Distinct from past RESTORE Parish Matching Program




FY24 Parish Matching Program Eligibility

- Coastal Zone Parishes may apply
 - Two parishes may partner up but one has to be identified as the lead
 - May include other non-Parish partners
- Must include match
- Project Types
 - Restoration, non-structural, drainage improvements, and as match to leverage in pursuit of federal grants
- Phases of Implementation
 - Construction
 - E&D may be considered only if proposal also includes project construction
