COAST BUILDERS COALITION

- Non-profit organization with the mission to support efforts to design, build and preserve the gulf coast.
 - Born out of discussions on how to best support Louisiana's coastal program
 - Grow the funding and then spend it in an efficient and effective manner
- Made up of the engineers, contractors, consultants, mitigation banks and others involved in coastal restoration and hurricane protection work.

INDUSTRY GROWTH

- Post-Katrina the Louisiana industry grew from \$100 million a year to over \$1 billion annually
 - Initial growth in funding from HSDRRS
 - Second phase from Deepwater Horizon
 - Many companies also involved in energy work and transportation work
- GNO estimates the Water Management sector employs nearly 30,000 people in Louisiana inclusive of:
 - \$1.7 billion State of Louisiana Annual Plan
 - City and parish water management efforts
 - Federal agency efforts including Corps of Engineers

INDUSTRY ACHIEVEMENTS

- Timely providing necessary equipment, including dredges
- Growing the workforce, with the help of Louisiana education institutions and state coordination efforts
- Coordination with CPRA to efficiently procure consulting and contracting services
- THE STATE'S COMMITMENT TO THE MASTER PLAN AND ANNUAL PLAN AS BEEN CRITICIAL TO SUCCESS IN THESE AREAS
- Louisiana is now exporting its coastal restoration and protection expertise around the nation and world
