Introduction

- **Purpose:** Support the implementation of projects that address the goals and objectives of the Master Plan and facilitate collaboration with Parishes
- Directly support Parish-led projects and leverage multiple sources of funding (Federal, Local, Private)
- FY2024 award is **\$7 million** of restoration or resilience work from state surplus and GOMESA funding



Eligibility Requirements

- Parishes apply directly for reimbursement funding
- Limited to LDENR Coastal Zone Management parishes
- Match is required (amount, type, and source of match is at Parish discretion)



Project Types

- Resilience/non-structural measures
- Vegetative plantings
- Invasive species removal and/or control
- Oyster reef/cultch placement
- Living shoreline
- Shoreline protection
- Hydrologic modification
- Terraces
- Marsh creation
- Barrier island and headland sand fencing



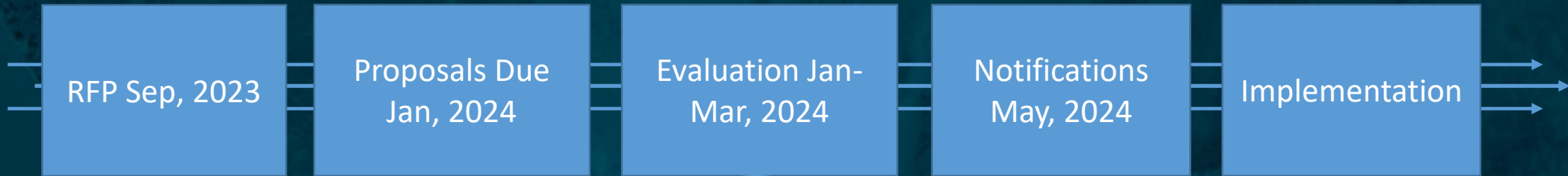

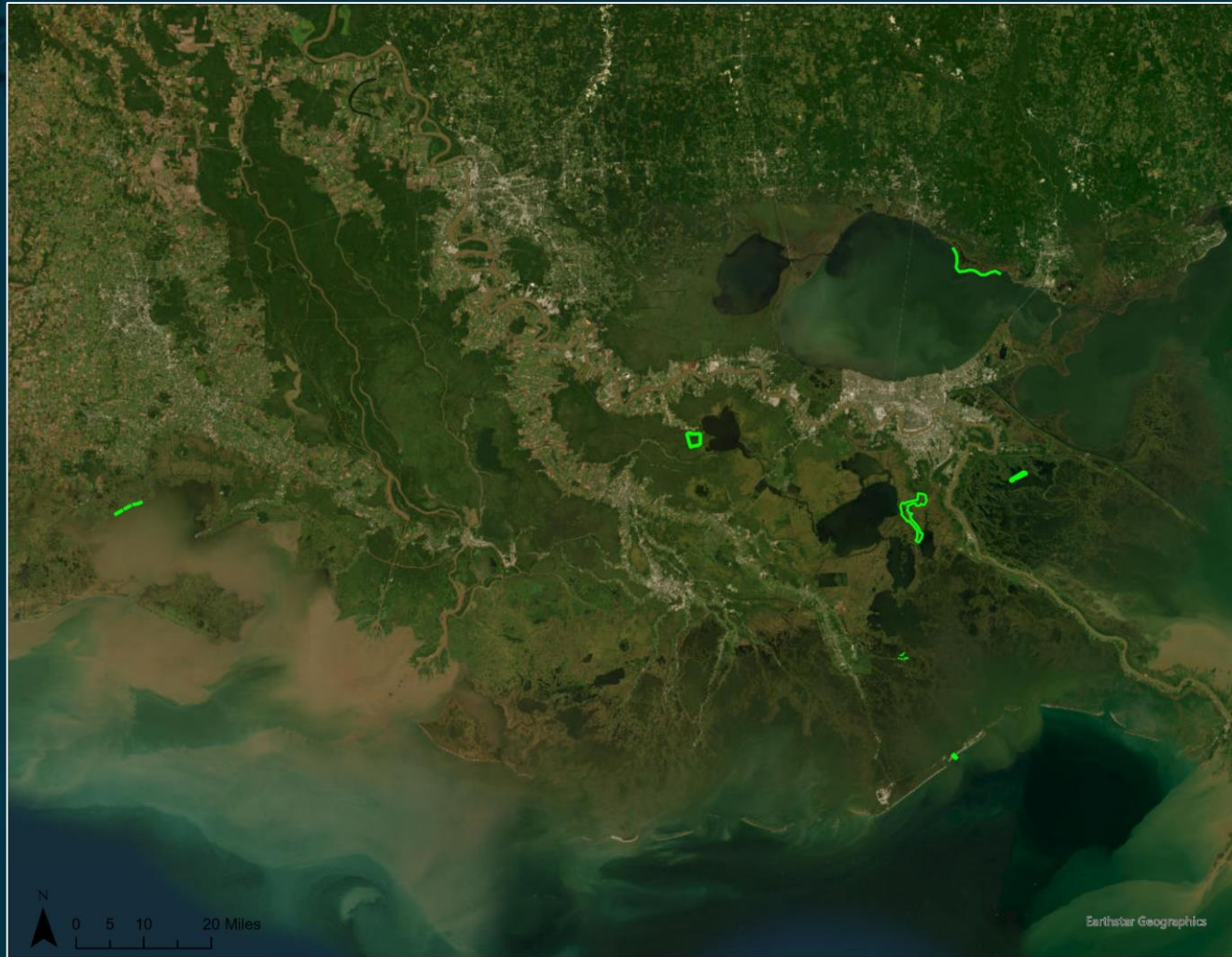


Project Highlights
