# Introduction

 Purpose: Support the implementation of projects that address the goals and objectives of the Master Plan and facilitate collaboration with Parishes

 Directly support Parish-led projects and leverage multiple sources of funding (Federal, Local, Private)

 FY2024 award is \$7 million of restoration or resilience work from state surplus and GOMESA funding




# Eligibility Requirements

 Parishes apply directly for reimbursement funding

Limited to LDENR Coastal Zone
 Management parishes

 Match is required (amount, type, and source of match is at Parish discretion)

- Resilience/non-structural measures
- Vegetative plantings
- Invasive species removal and/or control
- Oyster reef/cultch placement
- Living shoreline
- Shoreline protection
- Hydrologic modification
- Terraces
- Marsh creation
- Barrier island and headland sand fencing

RFP Sep, 2023 Proposals Due Jan, 2024 Evaluation Jan-May, 2024 Implementation

  - Project feasibility and constructability
  - Acreage restored and/or area benefitted

  - Synergy with other restoration and/or resilience efforts






