
SOUTHWEST COASTAL COASTAL STORM RISK MANAGEMENT

NED Flood Risk Reduction Plan

Nonstructural (raising residential structures): **100% Voluntary**

- Elevation of residential structures to 2075 100-year Base Flood Elevation (BFE)
- Dry flood-proofing of non-residential structures
- Risk reduction features (berms) for warehouses
- Includes 3,961 total structures
 - ➤ 3,462 residential
 - ➢ 342 non-residential
 - ➤ 157 warehouses

Total Cost of \$1.3 Billion






SOUTHWEST COASTAL ECOSYSTEM RESTORATION

NER National Ecosystem Restoration

- 9 Marsh Restoration Features
- 5 Shoreline Protection/Stabilization Features
- 35 Chenier Reforestation Features

Total Estimated Cost: \$5.5 Billion

Calcasieu Ship Channel Salinity Control Measure and Cameron-Creole Spillway Structure recommended for additional study

- Ecosystem Restoration
 - > **\$20M** Community Projects Funding (ecosystem restoration)

 - 19 structures have cleared all assessments and are ready to be raised:
 - ✓ 9 in Vermillion Parish
 - ✓ 10 in Calcasieu Parish
