- 3.5-mile floodwall system
- o 8 pump stations
- 13 sluice gates/lift gates
- 18 vehicular gates
- 1 pedestrian floodgate
- o 1 railroad gate
- o 6 road ramps
- Raising of the I-10 road surface

#### **NONSTRUCTURAL FEATURES:**

- Elevation of 5,583 preliminarily eligible residential structure
- Dry floodproofing of 827 nonresidential structures

Once completed, the project will provide flood risk reduction to more than 26 thousand structures.
