- CCRE members represent over 35 companies and organizations, including:



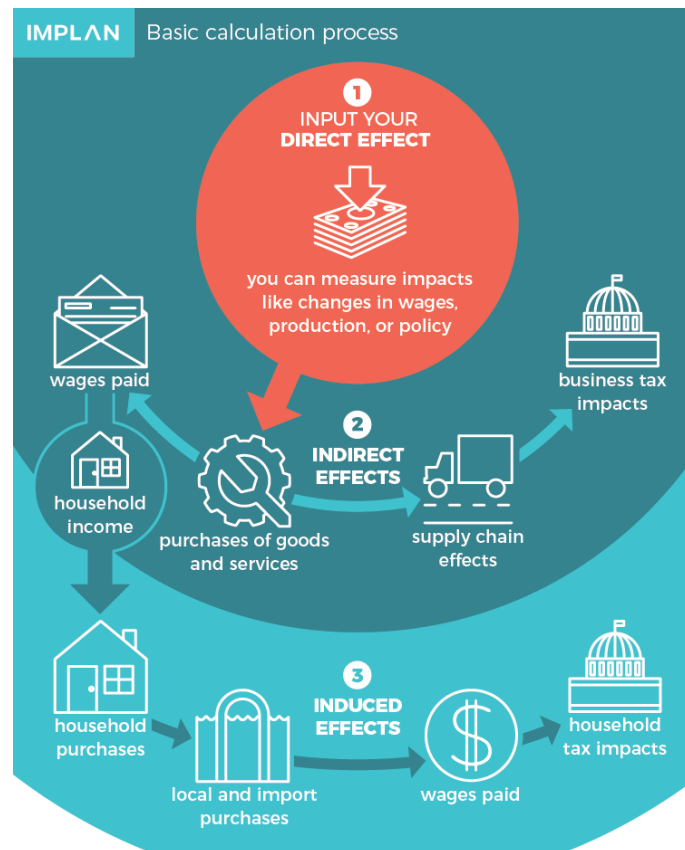
About CCRE

- ✓ **Create opportunities to engage local business and workforce in the Coastal Master Plan's implementation (e.g., Securing Coastal Contracts Workshops, annual job projection metrics)**
